We're proud to introduce **Growing Up Dairy** to you and your students. This free program allows students to follow the growth and development of a newborn dairy calf, and gives them an inside look at life on a dairy farm.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS:

- Once registered, an educator will send biweekly emails to you with updates on the calf (pictures, facts, etc.), as well as information on a topic related to the dairy farm, such as harvesting, vet visits, structures on the farm etc.
- You'll also receive extension activities for you to do with your class
- You'll also have the opportunity to ask the educator questions on behalf of your students (e.g. What is a cow's favourite food? How much does a cow poop in one day?)
- Extension activities will cover a wide range of subjects from grades K-8, including science, math, social studies, history, geography, language, visual arts, and pathways to success

EXAMPLE EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:

Grade 1 Math:

How much has the calf grown since birth? Illustrate using numbers and pictures

Grade 2 Science:

Investigate how farmers ensure cows have fresh air and water in the barn. Where does the water come from?

Grade 5 Social Studies:

Dairy cows are not indigenous to Canada. Investigate who brought them here and from where they originally came

- Activities are based on the Ontario curriculum, which will help you meet your classroom's learning objectives
